

Mr Iain D Anderson MBE MD FRCS (Eng, Edin, Glas) FRACS (Hon)

Iain Anderson has been Consultant Surgeon at Salford Royal Hospital, Manchester since 1995. He is a surgeon on the Intestinal Failure Unit, a national unit specialising in the treatment of intestinal fistulae and other complications after abdominal surgery. He trained in surgery in Manchester and Edinburgh and from 1994 developed and established the Care of the Critically Ill Surgical Patient (CCrISP) Course.

From 2011, he was Director of Emergency Surgery at ASGBI, chairing or contributing to working groups on Emergency Surgical Care and Peri-operative Care of the Higher Risk Surgical Patient. He chaired the interdisciplinary Emergency General Surgery Board (2015-2018) and is now President of ASGBI.

From 2012 – 2019 he was been the senior surgical advisor to the National Emergency Laparotomy Audit (NELA) and part of its steering group.
